### Reflections

When you consider this chapter in connection with the two greatest commandments—Love God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength, and love your neighbor as yourself—it provides some practical ways of doing them. The first section provides the reason why someone should seek godly wisdom and then the next two describe the benefits of living in godly wisdom and how to treat others.

This chapter could best be summed up in two passages: 3:5-6 and 3:27-28.

## Proverbs 3:5-6 NASB

- 5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart And do not lean on your own understanding.
- 6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He will make your paths straight.

#### Proverbs 3:27-28 NASB

27 Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, When it is in your power to do *it*.

28 Do not say to your neighbor, "Go, and come back, And tomorrow I will give *it*," When you have it with you.
